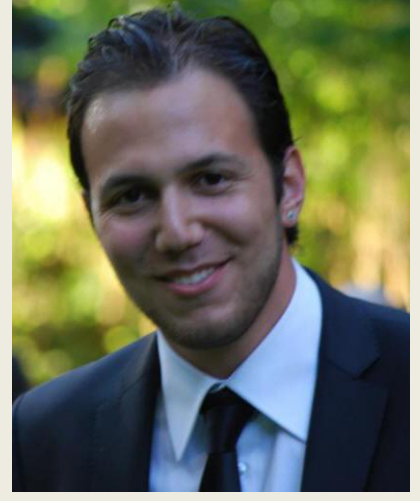

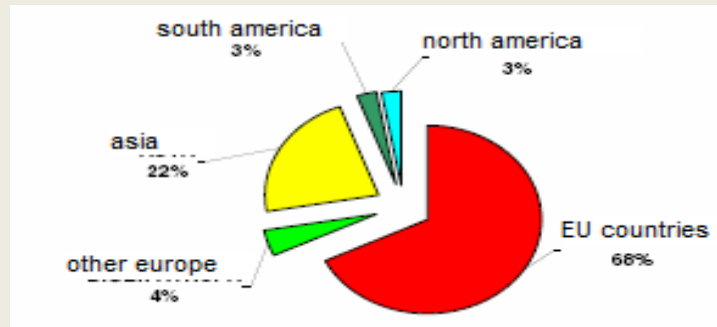

68 % of Turkey's plastic and rubber machinery importation is realized from EU countries.



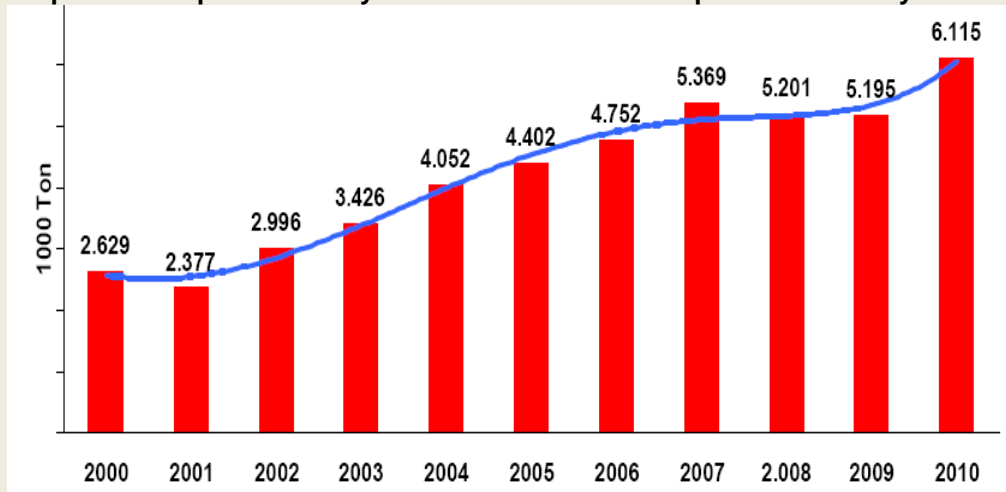

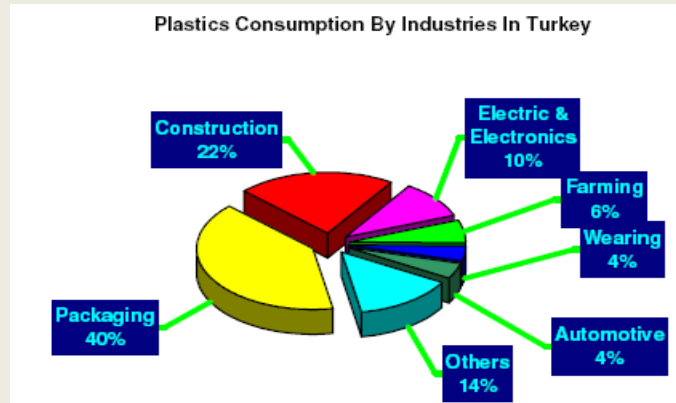

Almost 2/3 of Turkey's foreign trade is with EU countries.
Turkey ranks 7th in the EU's top import and 6th in top export markets.

By Air:

International flights land to İstanbul Atatürk International Airport,
or to Sabiha Gökçen (SAW) airport in the asian side.
Coming from İstanbul Atatürk International Airport, E6 TEM highway is to be followed
until Besiktas/Levent exit which takes you directly on the Buyukdere main street.
